Instructions for Your Upcoming Procedure

Your time is valuable, and we want you to be prepared for your procedure.

Please do the following on the day of your procedure:

- Arrive 30-40 minutes prior to your procedure time
- Bring your identification and insurance card (and method of payment as needed)
- Leave any jewelry or valuables at home. We are not responsible for lost items
- Bathe the morning of the procedure utilizing soap or a cleanser like HibiClens/Dyna-Hex
- Wear comfortable loose fitting clothing

There are certain conditions that can cause your procedure to be canceled.

Your procedure WILL BE canceled and rescheduled if:

- You have not completed the MRI/CT ordered by your Provider. We cannot do the procedure without that report.
- You have not stopped your **blood thinning medications**. You should only stop your **prescription medications** as directed by your provider. The following over the counter herbal supplements and medications are considered blood thinning and they must be stopped for **SEVEN (7) days** prior to your procedure:
 - **Herbals containing Ginger or Ginko Biloba**
 - **Fish Oil/Omega/Garlic**
 - **Aspirin or Aspirin containing medication like Aspirin/Excedrin/Equagesic**
 - **Non-Steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs like Advil/Motrin/Aleve/Naproxen**
- You are currently taking antibiotics for an acute illness.
- You are **ill/sick** in any capacity.
- **You ate or drank anything within 10 hours** of your scheduled time of your procedure
 - You can take your regularly prescribed medication with a small sip of water
- You had **dental work** performed within **the last 7 days to INCLUDE** getting your **teeth cleaned**.
- **You have not stopped your weight loss medication of semaglutide-type drugs (such as Ozempic, Wagovy, Zepbound (Mounjaro), Trulicity, etc.) for at least 14 days, when you are scheduled for your procedure at the Surgery Center.**

Do NOT stop your PRESCRIBED BLOOD thinning medications unless we notify you that your DOCTOR AGREES.
