

## **Instructions for Your Upcoming Procedure**

Your time is valuable, and we want you to be prepared for your procedure. Please do the following on the day of your procedure:

- Arrive 30-40 minutes prior to your procedure time
- Bring your identification and insurance card (and method of payment as needed)
- Leave any jewelry or valuables at home. We are not responsible for lost items
- Bathe the morning of the procedure utilizing soap or a cleanser like HibiClens/Dyna-Hex
- Wear comfortable loose fitting clothing
- Have a responsible adult drive you to and from your scheduled procedure.

## There are certain conditions that can cause your procedure to be canceled. Your procedure <u>WILL BE</u> canceled and rescheduled if:

- You have <u>not completed the MRI/CT ordered by your Provider</u>. We cannot do the procedure without that report.
- You have not stopped your <u>blood thinning medications</u>. You should only stop your <u>prescription medications</u> as directed by your provider. The following over the counter herbal supplements and medications are considered blood thinning and they must be stopped for <u>SEVEN (7) days</u> prior to your procedure:
  - Herbals containing Ginger or Ginko Biloba
  - Fish Oil/Omega/Garlic
  - Aspirin or Aspirin containing medication like Aspirin/Excedrin/Equagesic
  - Non-Steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs like Advil/Motrin/Aleve/Naproxen
- You are currently taking antibiotics for an acute illness.
- You are <u>ill/sick</u> in any capacity.
- You ate or drank anything within 10 hours of your scheduled time of your procedure
  - o You can take your regularly prescribed medication with a small sip of water
- You had dental work performed within the last 7 days to INCLUDE getting your teeth cleaned.
- You have not stopped your <u>weight loss</u> medication of semaglutide-type drugs (such as <u>Ozempic</u>, <u>Wagovy</u>, <u>Zepbound</u> (<u>Mounjaro</u>), <u>Trulcity</u>, etc.) for at <u>least 7 days</u>, when you are scheduled for your procedure at the <u>Surgery Center</u>.

<u>Do NOT stop your PRESCRIBED BLOOD thinning medications unless we notify you that</u> your DOCTOR AGREES.

(see blood thinning medication list)
